

- 3. Any seat falling vacant after period of 45 days shall not be filled and shall stand vacant/forfeited.
- 4. The candidates who apply for admission on the basis of fake certificates/ documents and detected at any stage shall be liable to prosecution under criminal law and their admission shall be cancelled. Institute/ University reserve right to take legal action against the candidate.
- 5. Candidate who is finally selected for admission in BS Degree Program shall have to pledge, through an affidavit that He/ She shall complete the course of BS Degree Programs. In case He /She leaves the College before completing the Course for any reason, He /She will submit a Pay Order/ Demand Draft of Rs. 150, 000/- (Rupees one hundred fifty thousandOnly) payable to the Principal, Bilawal Medical College, LUMHS, as a penalty for wasting a preciousseat.
